Charles Earle as Lucy has described founded the Barnes Hash in 1982/3. However, Nick revolutionised it and put the Far Eastern stamp on it as at that time we didn't have a proper circle or committee.

During Nick's tenure the Barnes Hash becomes known as the Yuppy Hash and we often had circa a hundred in the pack.

I then started hashing with Surrey and the week was very nicely balanced out with Barnes on Wednesdays and Surrey or East Grinstead on Sundays in the winter and Mondays in the summer.

Max had come back from Singapore in 1985 and was in the Wattenden Arms at Kenley having a quiet Sunday drink when the Surrey and East Grinstead hashes descended in an informal joint run. He was immediately recruited as had been missing his Far Eastern hashing.

We met going down the A22 in our respective cars going to an East Grinstead Hash at the Bell just east of Blindley Heath. He was in his red Porsche and kept trying to get past me in my Ford XR3i. I skidded on the gravel turning right and he zoomed past so then I was glaring at him in his rear view mirror. We then realised we were going to the same venue. His name evolved over his love of dressing up whenever possible as a transvestite Nazi in fishnet stockings!"

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Introducing the trail, Do You described it as a demonstration run. 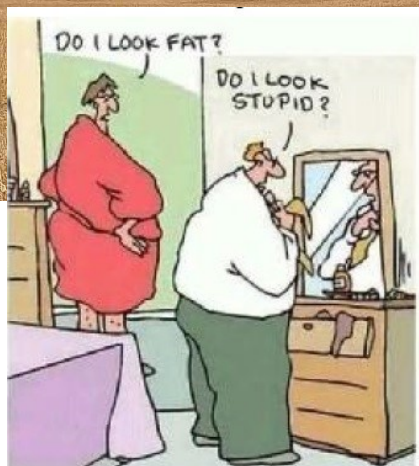
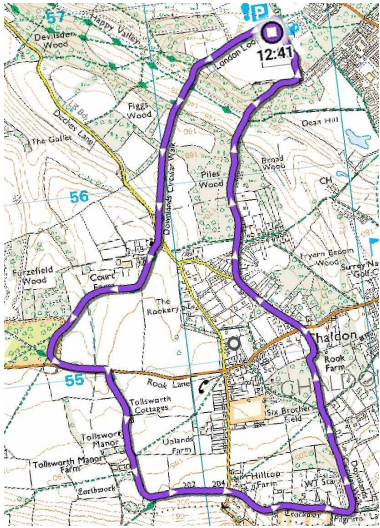

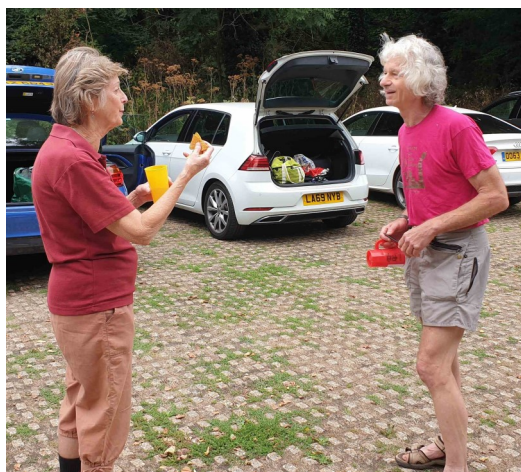
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The Galloping Oppos & SH3 :
