Speedy Humper for not setting the run at her spiritual home Guildford College.


Oh yes, it was a very enjoyable trail, thank you Speedy.

The hare told us at the Circle, to excuse any shortcomings in the trail, that in accompanying a grandchild round funfair attractions, she had done damage to her boobs (her word, not mine). We did finish on tarmac, coming up from the south-








Petal bats Raffles pool!
