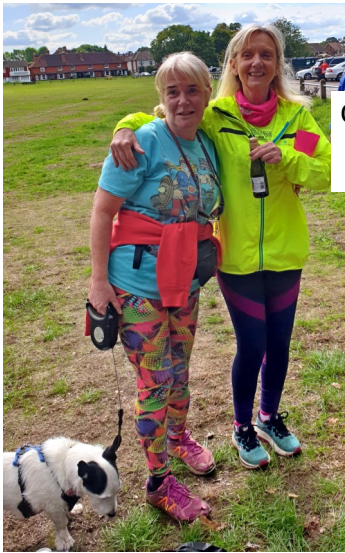

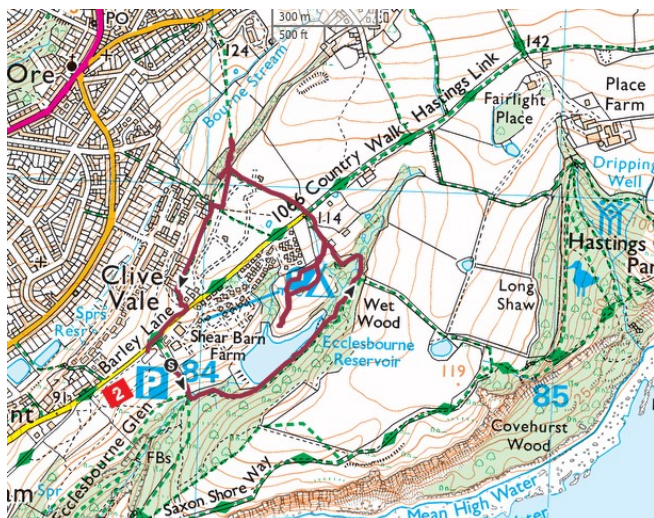

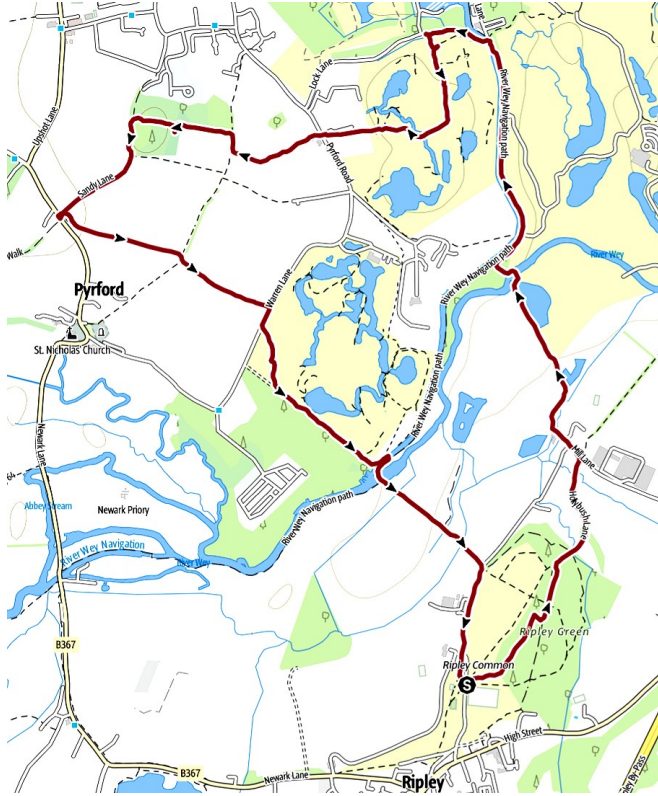
were in - but I spotted that and corrected it - Bastards!

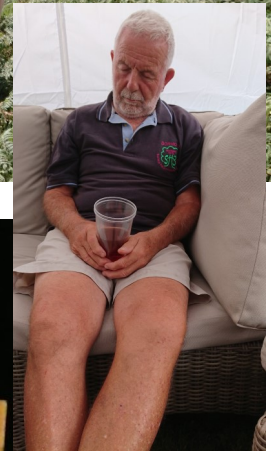
