


Into his nineties, his death resulted from a fall at home.

There must still be a few current Members who remember running with Ron and Carol before their move to the West Country, let's raise a glass! On-In Ron! RIP

A COLD COMING WE HAD OF IT

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When this morning I mentioned my having earlier volunteered to help J. Arthur lay his trail, he said "Look at it this way: like this you get to run a really first class trail". And indeed the earlier part, west of the main road, was original and challenging. Naturally we have been over that road before: SH3 seem to make a point of hashing from Ockley. After lockdown we seemed to be stuck there. But the hare made it different, with convoluted loops and changes of direction.

There followed a lengthy stretch of that road running south on tarmac, before we turned left into more familiar territory; hares at Ockley seem obsessed by Lake Vann, whose ice today would clearly never bear human weight. The

tragedy elsewhere today could not have happened on Lake Vann. Before we got there we had been bemused by a check (to those on white flour) from which blue, short-cut flour led away north. We took forever to realise that this blue flour might also lead to a white flour solution; Doug and RHUM were the ones who cracked it, though not before Atalanta had been some incredible distance in the only other plausible direction.

We had a good number of visitors, most of whom ran the full main trail in vigorous fashion, one with a dog who took no interest in Raffles, Pepper, or Spud: hashing canines are strangely unsocial. At the

start I had seemed the only runners with bare legs, but no, some of our guest runners bared their knees, and then came Stevie Blunder, late to begin the trail. The frost on the trees made the landscape very attractive: Kelinchi had her camera out several times. Sunshine would have enhanced the effect, but our skies remained a heavy grey.

J. Arthur had bemused his audience before the start explaining his use of red, white and blue, plus sawdust as an alternative to white flour; the main trail he said was 5 miles long. I would judge that Atalanta was in after 80 minutes: no, not slow for her, she runs the checks with enthusiasm, and today the hare had indeed made them interesting. It was impressive to see how many runners more or less kept up with her, even if we

omit our guests from this total. So yes, a very successful trail; let's hear it for J.Arthur!

It is fair to suppose (has anyone ever checked?) that few people think of Santa Claus in his earlier form, Saint Nicholas. The life of the holy man – well, in legend – includes his putting through windows enough money for dowries for the young women living there; not unlike Santa and our chimneys. Christians can scarcely complain that Christ has disappeared from Christmas, except in our postage stamps; after all, they took over the festival of the winter solstice from pagans, and must now with a good grace surrender it once more to pagans. 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







