A missive from Olive Oyl:





## The Met cracks down on Anti Social Hashing

Official Metropolitan Police report on the first patrol of the new Met Unit 'Police Intervention Squad Stopping antisocial Perpetrators On Our Roads (Pisspoor)'. As per recent instructions from the Commissioner, the report now shows the full list of active and spent disciplinary and criminal offences by the officers involved.
