not disregarded. Mind you, even here the hoo-ha over Gary Lineker shows that our government too panders to this same hostility to foreigners who risk their lives come here. As to for Netanyahu, British Jews feel torn in voicing their opinions: should they encourage, or even join, criticism of the Israeli government, or does that just give credit to anti-Semitism?

Populism can be defeated at the polls: think of Trump or Bolsonaro. But it will never be easy; populist regimes (think of New Delhi, Ankara) or oppressive ones, (Moscow, Beijing) are very good at suppressing criticism or even freedom of speech.
