Yes, Petal did spend most of a day languishing in a cell with no belt and shoelaces. Yes, all roads around his house were sealed off and his neighbours told to be prepared to evacuate. Yes, there were 6 firearms officers and numerous attack dogs straining at their leads! And a nice chap like Craig from Coronation Street to have a soothing chat with after the drama had passed.

No, he hadn't refused to pay the ULEZ charge - he had paid his £12-50, BUT he also raised a question about the compliance of his vehicle, which was unclear.
