The car parks filled up fast: plainly the area is at least as popular as when Spingo brought us here, repeatedly. Oh, and other hares too: an unrivalled place to start a Reigate hash. Well, sometimes we have started from the Skimmington Castle; today the trail brought us by devious and ingenious means to run as if from that pub. In the hares' honour it must be said that after we got away from that pub much of the trail was original, which is quite an achievement in this area. There was an interesting moment at a check: Doug said "We used to go this way", but then followed Dormouse elsewhere, and when Tosser chose that path, our Uncle called "That's too easy!", but Tosser had got it right. Re: Run 2469

There are some lessons to be learned and I certainly have! My provision of a spread of food at the circle takes preparation time and, as a lone hare, it precluded my laying the main trail and the S/C on the day, it was a "bridge too far". I laid the trail on the evening before and the "blue" S/C on the day. I will never provide food on my runs again. I will, however (with agreement), do so at someone else's. Again, setting it all out prevented me from going around with the pack. I agree with FRB that this is the best practice so that instead of checks just being kicked through, blobs can be added, which is especially helpful with back-checks. It also deals with trail sabotage that we have experienced.

When I laid the S/C I had to follow the 1st mile of the trail and discovered that some flour had all but disappeared (just a smattering) other blobs, especially on trees (which I use, where possible) looked freshly laid. I remember a (WH3) Mother Brown run on a balmy summer evening, where there at least five slugs on every blob! But slugs, dew or sabotage (of which I found no evidence) it's best to lay the trail on the day and go round with the pack.

Considering the above it was serendipitous that most of the pack finished together although RHUM's phone was, probably, a help. Apart from those late finishers that FRB mentioned, CL also needed guidance (by phone). I briefed Strumpet how to negotiate the S/C but she was seduced by a sunny bench and spent the whole time there. It wasn't a waste, however, as Silent Knight gave up the main trail at the airfield and went back via the S/C. I knew it was the "Barnes weekend" and I managed to get the food right. Apart from condiments etc. there was just one porcini roll left over, which I consumed.
