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


visitor, a lady accompanying our new friends Followthrough and Allover (if I heard their names aright). Many thanks to our hares.

It is interesting to examine Shakespeare's take on romantic love. Few commentators emphasise an interesting insight: that the Pyramus play is a parody on his own Romeo and Juliet story. "Sighing like furnace, with a woeful ballad made to his mistress' eyebrow" is obviously scornful; "Most loving mere folly" is from the same play. In Love's Labours Lost the men and women do not get together at all; it ends "You that way, we this". The contrived pairing of Beatrice and Benedick is hardly a traditional love story.; the bizarre union in All's Well That Ends Well is not a love story at all. Shakespeare's own marriage failed; his subsequent

life seems to have been bisexual. His sonnets have a devastating indictment of desire: "The expense of spirit in a waste of shame/ Is lust in action..." - read the whole poem. Nor are all women idealised; Cressida is unfaithful, Gertrude remarries absurdly quickly, and as for Regan and Goneril..... (It is startling to think that boy actors could play these still more parts, the genuinely sexy and Cleopatra). mature Shakespeare would not have appealed to Mills and Boon readers. So: how should Isabella react to the Duke's last lines Measure for Measure?

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
