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

The area is of course built

up, which meant we were on road at times, but to be fair these encounters with tarmac made up only a minor fraction of the run, and the scenery in the various parks and green spaces we visited was excellent., Hills certainly, but not too steep or long, and plenty of good autumn colour, all rather attractive, and clear pleasant weather.

The spire was a minor loss, dating back only to 1835. Other earlier spires had come and gone, but the towers are irreplaceable.


